"The PCC recently decided to stop the practice of communicants dipping their wafer into the chalice, when receiving communion. This is in line with Diocesan and Church of England advice. Communicants are free to drink from the chalice, which is wiped clean after every use. It is also perfectly OK for communicants to receive in one kind (the host or wafer) only. The doctrine of concomitance makes it very clear that to receive in just one kind is still to make a full communion."
